What are carnets? How are they used? Find out at this breakfast seminar, featuring Amanda Barlow of the United States Council for International Business (USCIB). The USCIB helps facilitate international trade through its work on harmonization of commercial practices in the ICC. It issues and guarantees **ATA Carnets**, also known as "Merchandise Passports." These are international customs documents that simplify customs procedures for

the temporary importation of various types of goods. In the U.S. and 85 customs territories, **ATA Carnets** ease the temporary importation of **commercial samples (CS)**, **professional equipment (PE)**, and goods for **exhibitions and fairs (EF)**. They facilitate international business by avoiding extensive customs procedures, eliminating payment of duties and value-added taxes (minimum 20% in Europe, 27% in China), and replacing the purchase of temporary import bonds.

Carnets save time, effort, and money. They may be used for unlimited exits from and entries into the U.S. and foreign countries (carnets are valid for one year); are accepted in over 85 customs territories; eliminate value-added taxes (VAT), duties and the posting of security normally required at the time of importation; simplify customs procedures; and facilitate reentry into the U.S. by eliminating the need to register the goods with U.S. Customs at the time of departure.
